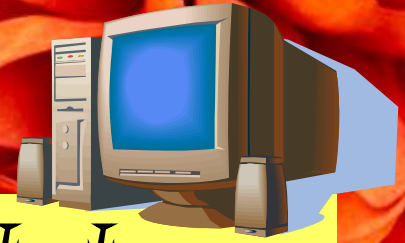

Each classroom has...

- An Interactive Whiteboard/Smartboard
- Wireless internet
- 4 student computers
- 1 teacher computer
- A projector
- A DVD player

Email



- Check minimum of twice daily to receive important information
- Answer parent emails within 48 hours during school year
- Do not put student's full name in subject line or content of email
- Do not send out forwarded or mass personal emails on school mailing lists.

Facebook...

- Don't add students to your personal Facebook or other social network sites.
- Don't post information about students, the school to your page
- Keep profile private (recommended)
- Avoid posting questionable pictures that could be viewed by parents, colleagues, etc.



Edline

- Online dashboard for each class
- Post homework assignments
- Post links to activities/enrichment
- Email communication with parents, students
- Record grades
